I. Area Web Page

In regard to the ITC, the Web-Servant will have complete authority and responsibility for the website. In the event the Web-Servant does not post a requested item they will immediately notify the requester of the reason and will include the ITC Chairman and the Policy Chairman on the reply. There will be no further input from ITC members for events, web site development ideas, etc. (except as outlined in item IV of this discussion) nor will anyone other than the Web-Servant post anything to the website nor modify the website in any way except as specifically requested. The Web-Servant has full authority to interact with area officers, but the ITC Chairman should be included on the correspondence. The Web-Servant can and should, of course, request help from ITC members at any time.

II. Day-To-Day Focus

The day-to-day focus of the ITC should be to provide support for Area Committee meetings, Area assemblies, workshops, etc. All ITC members are provide hands on support for these events.

III. Developmental Focus

Our developmental focus should be on alternate methods of area communications such as anonymity protected email, Slack (or equivalent) or other means that avoid the current anonymity issues.

IV. Future Innovation that involve the Website

If we have ideas for future website innovation, we should proceed as follows

- Come to a consensus with the ITC and formulate a presentation for the ACM
- Present to the ACM and, if necessary. to the Area Assembly
- Task the Web-Servant to implement
