Drunks Only: Sarah not here. Per Bryan seems meeting going OK. Missed some newcomers, need to set the tiles on the first page so don't miss them. Bryan will send out the paper.

4<sup>th</sup> dimension: Jeffrey did talk to Coleen she said its going well. Had a deaf secretary for last 2 months. Strong deaf participation.

Spiritual awakening: Art is not here. Sat March 8 at 7am. Have a business meeting. Can be included in that list – if want to- ask Jeffrey.

Oldtown: Jamie: everything going good. Recently extended the meeting by 10 minutes. New rate of \$60 for interpreters. Have the attendance has been stable.

Carlsbad workshop: No rep. Bryan says no problem. Don't remember how many deaf showing up there but maybe 5-10.

Joy of living: Renea has heard nothing. Have continued to ask for a rep but no one showed up. Jeffrey has concern about checks being sent without communication. Cait said when she goes to Carlsbad will try to reach out to a member. Need to get representation.

Designs for living: Tyler (gold can representative): all going well. Will take the suggestion for the tiles for next biz meeting. Attendance has been a little lower across the board, ASL attendance in proportion to overall attendance. Bryan has been the only person there a couple times. Not good. Maybe I missed them Bryan said.

### **Old business:**

Previously had to pay for EIN, then got money back. The money that was reimbursed to Jeffrey-the check was shredded. Need to get an EIN for a "Non-Profit Social Club." Jeffrey will reach out to Jerry to follow up. Need to separate from District 6 whose EIN we have been using.

#### **New business:**

Interpreter pay increase: Suzanne: to keep up with the cost of living in SD. Other meetings pay \$60-\$70 per hour. Rate has been 50 for a long time. 7<sup>th</sup> tradition: we are self-supporting through our own contribution. Need to up the contributions.

Tradition 8: "Special services may be recompensed" Special workers. To support the development of an informed motion Jerry will request information – a poll on how much interpreters are paid.
