Discussion: Adrian shared that the Hispanic community and the Native American community both reported a lack of physical connection with rest of area. Adrian visited district 15 and 18 (Spanish-speaking districts) face to face. He acknowledged his skill set of being bilingual was of huge service and he was very grateful to be able to use it to interact and connect with those districts. Next goal is to have an area hybrid workshop with all the respective groups listed above represented and potentially do some problem solving with their issues

- Where to distribute district funds. Sky Hi distribution suggestions were reviewed but not pursued. Adrian did review pamphlet "Where money and spirituality meet" advising, per treasurer report, that \$1700 was too much money for the district to be holding...it needs to be used to spread the message
  - Discussion Ray advised we need to be sure we do have funds for upcoming workshops and activities, especially if they are back in person.
  - Will ongoing discussion of fund distribution
- Motion to increase ASL Interpreter salary from \$50/hr to \$65 will be voted on at ACM in September
