

DCM DISTRICT 6 MONTHLY MEETING

MONDAY OCTOBER 9, 2023

ACTING DCM MAIRE'S REPORT

- Kerry from District 19 has set the arrival time for the breakfast/lunch committee at 6:45 am for the November 11 Assembly.
- Maire reports hearing from area chairpersons that 7th Tradition pie chart donations to the Area are down and has affected proposed budgets for 2024. CONVERSELY, SD Intergroup has a big surplus. The situation was reversed last year and probably caused groups to change their pie charts to meet the Intergroup deficit. GSRs should be tasked with:
 - a. Asking their groups for ideas to use these Intergroup monies; i.e.: 12 Step workshop suggestions; and;
 - b. Ask their groups (if they changed their pie charts last year) to return their pie charts to the more equitably distribute their 7th Trad monies

TREASURER'S REPORT (MAIRE)

- District 6 has over \$2600 (including \$300 prudent reserve) in our checking account.
- Maire has set aside \$500 for the Alkathon and \$500 for the Assembly so we still have \$1300 (\$1600 total, but \$300 of which is prudent reserve)

OTHER REPORTS

- Our friend, Brian, from the deaf community is going to the No Barriers meeting tomorrow to ask what time slots—besides the already reserved 6 pm time slot for the deaf-chaired meeting—the community would like for ASL interpretation to be provided.
- Karl asked if we needed a group conscience as per the proposed 2024 budget (yes)
- Joey motioned that we accept the Treasurer's Report as submitted. Seconded by Nicole. Approved unanimously.

GSR REPORTS

- Karl reported that North Park Men's is a healthy 30 to 40+ average attendance. A good, weekly check-in meeting
- Nicole reports that her meeting Friday Night Gratitude voted 'yes' to participate in the NYE Alkathon. They voted to move their Business Mtg to Assembly but there was not much interest. She may decide to create a folder with such information and have it by the Literature Table for anyone who wishes to look
